

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Land pay to any person now or
hereafter, nine dollars fifty five cents for the purchase of firewood, to be accounted for.

July 9th 1832

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Land pay William Keown
or order seventy five dollars for one quarter salary as a summer at Easton, due in
first Instance.

The following orders were issued for the surrender of the fugitive
therein named, upon the Demand and information and evidence therein
mentioned. Viz

The State of Maryland, To the Sheriff of Baltimore
or any other County, in this State, greeting. Whereas, it appears from authentic
documents, certified and transmitted to the Executive Department of this State
by His Excellency George Wolf Governor of the State of Pennsylvania
that a certain Patrick Hewitt, stands charged on oath with having committed
fornication and bastardy with a certain Mary Burk of the County of Lancaster
in the said State, and that the said Patrick Hewitt has fled from the
Justice of the said State and now resides within seven miles of the City of
Baltimore in this State. And whereas the said George Wolf Governor
as aforesaid, hath, in pursuance of the authority given in such cases by
the Constitution and Laws of the United States, demanded the said
Patrick Hewitt of the Executive of this State, as a fugitive from Justice
and appointed Adam Bare inquire, Sheriff of the said County of Lancaster
his agent to receive the said fugitive and transport him to the said State
of Pennsylvania for trial for the said offence. Now therefore, I
George Howard Governor of the State of Maryland, have thought
proper, in compliance with the said Demand, to order and direct the
Surrender of the said fugitive, and do hereby order and direct, that
you forthwith arrest and deliver the said Patrick Hewitt, if he
be found within your bailiwick to the said Adam Bare agent
aforesaid; he the said agent first paying all costs of the arrest and
detention of the said fugitive. For all which this shall be your sufficient
Warrant. Given under my hand and the Great Seal of the State
of Maryland this ninth day of July in the year of our Lord, one thousand
eight hundred and thirty two, and of the Independence of the United
States the fifty seventh.
