

July 30th 1832

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay (George) Gilpin or order seventy five dollars for delivering the Laws and Writs, and process and other documents to the Clerks of the Federal Courts on the Western Shore.

July 31st 1832

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay George Thompson or order fifty dollars for delivering the Laws and Writs, and process and other documents to the Clerks of the Federal Courts on the Eastern Shore.

Wednesday August 1 1832.

The Council met this day upon the call.

Thursday August 2nd 1832.

The Council met P. M. P. E. N. T. The same as yesterday.

Ordered that the Treasurer at Annapolis deliver to Captain Ebenezer Luthcum, or order forty eight Muskets and accoutrements for the use of the Company under his command.

His Excellency the Governor this day granted a Pardon in Equity to Jeremiah Tolson, of Dorchester County, on account of selling negroes entitled to their freedom to a foreigner. (See Pardon Record).

His Excellency also this day granted the following Pardon: To Jonathan Goss, on account of Stealing, of which he was convicted in Calvert County Court at November Term 1828, and for which he was sentenced to the Penitentiary for five years.

St. Mark Bowen, on account of Felony, of which he was convicted in Baltimore City Court at November Term 1826 and for which he was sentenced to the Penitentiary for a year. (See Pardon Record).
