 from ^{the} Justice of this State: and I do hereby authorize and direct you, upon
 receiving the said fugitives to bring them into this State, and convey and
 deliver them to the Warden of the Jail of Baltimore County to answer for
 having stolen and carried away from the City of Baltimore, two Horses
 belonging to James H. McCulloch Esquire of the said City.
