

His Excellency the Governor this day granted a Pardon to Samuel Owen, on account of beating, of which he was convicted in Washington County Court at November Term 1831, and for which he was sentenced to the Penitentiary for six years. (See Pardon Record)

Ordered that the Armorer of the Western should pay to Captain John Thomas, Jr. or his order thirty Rifles and accoutrements for the use of the company under his command.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western should pay Josiah Bagly or order two hundred dollars for his services in preparing to aid his deputy in a prosecution of the late Judge Keason for misbehavior in office.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western should pay George Riggs or order thirty three dollars twenty seven cents for compensation and expenses for bringing a fugitive from Justice from Washington to Baltimore, amount proved and paid.

November 5th 1831

His Excellency the Governor this day granted a Pardon to Stephen Calloway on account of Kidnapping, of which he was convicted in Dorchester County Court at October Term 1827, and for which he was sentenced to the Penitentiary for ten years.

November 6th 1832

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western should pay Elizabeth Simms or order six dollars twenty five cents for one quarter salary for cleaning the public Splee, due the first Instant.

A Copy of the Record of conviction of Isaiah Willin in Dorchester County Court at October Term 1832, for Murder in the first degree, having been received. His Excellency the Governor this day signed and caused to be issued and sent to the Sheriff of the said County a Warrant for the execution of the said Isaiah Willin in the following words and figures viz

The State of Maryland, to the Sheriff of Dorchester County greeting. Whereas Isaiah Willin late of Somerset County, was convicted in Dorchester County Court at October Term one thousand eight hundred and thirty two of Murder in the first degree and by the said Court sentenced to be hung by the neck until he be dead. Now therefore there are to will and require, as also to charge and command you, that on or before 12 of the clock on Friday the Instant you take the said Isaiah Willin from your Prison and him safely convey
