

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay David Lloyd  
in order six dollars for sundry incidental expenses of the Library & amount  
approved and passed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Amos Green  
in order sixteen dollars, viz \$2 for advertising relations to stationery, \$5 for  
publishing two Proclamations for thanksgiving and \$9 for printing for the  
Library & amount approved and passed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Jeremiah  
Laughes in order thirty six dollars and fifty cents, viz \$26 for 13 copies of  
the Laws of the last General Assembly, \$2.50 for a Barrell of Lime and  
carting & \$3 for publishing notice of three meetings of the Executive, \$3 for  
publishing a Proclamation of Congressional Election and \$2 for publishing  
Proclamation for thanksgiving, & amount approved & passed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay  
Henry Thompson in order thirty dollars for a horse which died and  
for which he had to pay said sum, whilst he was in the performance  
of his duty in delivering the Laws & Votes and Proceedings to the Clerks  
of the several Counties in the Eastern Shore.

November 27th 1832  
Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay  
James Hildy in order fifteen dollars for one quarter Rent of New  
House and the fire insurance.

November 29th 1832  
Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay  
William McNeil in order ninety five dollars for balance of his  
account for printing added to the Laws & prepared by Edward Pearce  
Grove, Hattings and Joseph Mc Nicholas Engravers, under contract with  
the Executive by virtue of a Resolution of the General Assembly.

November 30th 1832.  
A Report of James O'Connell Inspector General of  
Flour in the City of Baltimore in relation to the conduct of the  
Assistant Inspectors, and their qualifications & as required by the 8th  
Section of the act of the last General Assembly relating to the inspection  
of Flour was received, and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay John  
C. Geiter in order thirty three dollars for publishing in his paper the  
several acts of Assembly relative to the colored population, and to  
Licenses by direction of the Clerk of the Council, in virtue of a Resolution  
of the General Assembly.
