Upon consideration of the claim of Joshua Guyton, Sheriff of Harford
County, for money paid and expended by him in apprehending Negroes who
had been in his custody, under a charge of the crime of Arson, and of the
Resolution of the General Assembly, requesting the Governor & Council to
examine into said claim and to make such allowance therefor as they might
deem proper, it was determined to allow for said claim the sum of two
hundred dollars.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Joshua
Guyton Sheriff of Harford County, or order two hundred dollars for money
paid and expended by him in apprehending Negroes who had been in his
custody under a charge of the crime of Arson, and had escaped from the Jail
of said County, This order given in virtue of a Resolution of the General
Assembly, at its present Session.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore, pay Charles
Elliott, or order six dollars, viz \$33 for publishing in their
paper the Laws relating to people of colour and to Licenses, \$6 for publishing
two Proclamations for thanksgiving, and three dollars for publishing
Proclamation relative to Electoral Election, \$ amount proved.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay
B. Spencer, or order six dollars for publishing in his paper an advertisement
relative to the Electoral District, and a Proclamation for thanksgiving
by order of the Executive, \$ amount proved.
