The Council met pursuant to the same as on yesterday

On the nomination of His Excellency the Governor, and by and with the advice and consent of the Council, the following civil appointments were made, and commissions issued accordingly, viz.

Alfred Tolson, Richard A. C. Magruder, Marvine T. Lamar, and Isaac G. Magruder, additional Justices of the Peace for Prince Georges County.

William Stewart a Director of the Penitentiary, vice Jesse Hunt resigned.

The several Bonds of Samuel Stump, Inspector General of Flour, of Jacob Beard, one of the assistant Inspectors of Flour in the City of Baltimore, and of John S. Williams, one of the Commissioners of Lotteries for the faithful performance of their several and respective duties, were laid before the board, and examined and approved.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Washington G. Puck or owed twenty three dollars viz \$22 for firing Salutes in honor of Charley Carroe of Carrollton, and upon the qualification of the Governor, and \$1 for mending the State Flag, for amount allowed.

Thursday February 28 1833
