The following demands were made this day, upon the Honorable  
William Branch, Chief Justice of the Circuit Court of the District of Columbia, for the  
persons therein named as fugitives from Justice, upon application, and the  
information and evidence therein mentioned being filed in the Council Chamber.

To the Honorable William Branch, Chief Justice of the Circuit  
Court of the District of Columbia: Whereas a certain David Whittle late  
of Prince Georges County, Maryland, discharged by indentment of the Grand Inquest  
of the State of Maryland, for the body of the said County of Prince Georges  
with having, on the twenty third day of March 1833, for the sake of unlaw-  
gain, received from negro John the slave of Zachariah Berry of the said  
County, ten bushels of Corn of the value of ten dollars, of the value of  
and chattels of the said Zachariah Berry, then lately before feloniously  
stolen, taken and carried away by the said negro John, slave as aforesaid  
to the said David then and there well knowing the said Corn to have  
been feloniously stolen, taken and carried away. And it hereupon  
has been received at the Executive Department of this State, that  
David Whittle has fled from Justice and is now concealed in  
Washington County, in the District of Columbia. And it is
