Given under my hand, and the great Seal of the State of Maryland, this sixth day of April in the year second, one thousand eight hundred and thirty three and of the independence of the United States the fifty seventh.

April 9th 1833

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Thomas B. Williams ten or nine hundred and twenty five dollars, for one quantity of land is a member of the Council, due to the first Assistant.

April 12th 1833

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay William Brown of Doon, or nine hundred and twenty five dollars, and pay to him the first Assistant for one quantity of land after deducting the amount of fees received, for the same land.

Monday April 15th 1833

His Excellency the Governor attended in the Council Chamber.

Tuesday April 16th 1833

His Excellency the Governor attended in the Council Chamber, and granted.

His Excellency the Governor and the Council attended in the Council Chamber, and granted a grant of land to the heirs of the late John Smith, deceased, on the 15th day of April, 1833.
