

Wednesday June 19th 1833

His Excellency this day granted a Pardon to Peter Murphy, on account of keeping or gaming tables of which he was convicted on three several Indictments in Baltimore. (The Court at June Term Instant, and for which he was sentenced to pay a fine of fifty dollars, and to suffer thirty days imprisonment in each case.) (See Pardon Record)

His Excellency also this day granted a Pardon to Michael Cozger on account of having committed a Rape on the body of Letitia Cain, on the 10th day of April 1833, of which he was convicted in Frederick County Court, at May Term 1833, and for which he was sentenced to the Penitentiary for five years. (See Pardon Record)

Thursday June 20th 1833.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay P. A. Vicklin & J. Johnson, or order one hundred and sixty seven dollars ninety five cents for books for the Library & certificate of the Librarian, in virtue of Resolution no 18 of the last General Assembly.

Monday July 5 1833.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Joseph A. Nicholson or order thirty seven dollars fifty cents, for one quarter's salary as Clerk of the Senate, due this day.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay David Rigely or order two hundred dollars, for one quarter's salary as Librarian, due this day.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay James Thomas or order two hundred and sixty six dollars sixty six cents, for one quarter's salary as Governor, due this day.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Thomas Culbreth or order three hundred and seventy five dollars, for one quarter's salary as Clerk of the Council, due this day.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Wm. Bowie or order one hundred and twenty five dollars, for one quarter's salary as a member of the Council, due this day.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Wm. Turner or order one hundred and twenty five dollars, for one quarter's salary as a member of the Council, due this day.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay G. Tuck or order one hundred and twenty five dollars, for one quarter's salary as Armorer of the Armory, due this day.
