

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Henry Thompson or order one hundred and thirty dollars fifty cents, for one quarter salary as the speaker of the Council, and for taking care of the State House &c. due this day.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Richard Mills or order sixty two dollars fifty cents, for one quarter salary as steward to the Governor, due this day.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay George G. Brecken or order seventy five dollars, for one quarter salary as Clerk of the House of Delegates, due this day.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Watson Leache or order forty dollars, for one quarter pension, due this day.

Tuesday July 2nd 1833.

His Excellency the Governor, this day granted a Pardon to Nathan Armistead, on account of preceding and selling one silver Table Spoon, the value of one dollar and fifty cents, the property of Richard Linnon, and for which he was sentenced to the Penitentiary for two years. (See Pardon Record)

Wednesday July 3rd 1833.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Henry Thompson or order ten dollars thirty cents, for the purchase of firewood, to be accounted for.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay William Nevins or order seventy five dollars, for one quarter salary as Armourer at Easton, due the 1st instant.

Friday July 5th 1833.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay William Durbin or order seventy five dollars, for one quarter salary as Armourer at Frederick, due the 1st instant.

Tuesday July 9th 1833.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Thomas Worthington or order one hundred and twenty five dollars, for one quarter salary as a member of the Council, due the 1st instant.
