

Wednesday July 10th 1833

His Excellency the Governor, granted a Pardon to Garrison Gibson, on account of an assault on James Harlock, and robbing him of twenty nine dollars fifty cents, of which he was convicted in Rochester June 5th at Spring Term 1833, and for which he was sentenced to ten years confinement in the Penitentiary. (See Court Record).

Thursday July 11th 1833

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay William Potter or order one hundred and twenty five dollars for one quarter salary as a member of the Council due the first Instant.

Friday July 12th 1833

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Jonas Green or order seventy one dollars thirty three cents for one quarter salary due the first Instant, viz \$45.53 for the Executive, \$12.55 for the Treasurer, \$10.10 for the Adjutant General, and \$3.66 for the Librarian, of amount proved.

Monday July 29th 1833

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Thomas Franklin, Surviving Executor of John Shaw or order fifty two dollars fifty cents, for one year and six months Rent of Gun House, up to the first Instant of contract.

Friday August 2nd 1833

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Elizabeth Simmons or order six dollars seventy five cents for one quarter salary for cleaning the Public Temple due the first Instant.

Wednesday August 15th 1833

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay William Brown or order one hundred and sixty three dollars fifty one cents for balance due him for quarter salary up to the first Instant, as Examiner General, after deducting the amount of fees received of amount proved.

Monday August 19th 1833

The Council met agreeably to notice
