

Wednesday November the 6th 1833
Returns of the election held on the sixth sitting for Sheriff of
Allegheny County, having been received, by which it appears that Lawrence
O'Holt had the greatest number of legal votes, and was duly elected and
first named in the said return, as Sheriff of the said County, a Commission
was this day issued, to the said Lawrence O'Holt, as Sheriff as aforesaid.

Wednesday November 13th 1833.
Returns of the election held on the seventh sitting for Sheriff of
Montgomery County, having been received, by which it appears that Richard R. Waters
had the greatest number of legal votes, and was duly elected, and first named
in the said return, as Sheriff of the said County, a Commission was this day
issued to the said Richard R. Waters, as Sheriff as aforesaid.

Saturday November 16th 1833
Returns of the elections held on the seventh sitting for Sheriff of
Washington and Talbot Counties, respectively, having been received, and it
appearing by the said Returns from Washington County, that Daniel Malot,
had the greatest number of legal votes, and was duly elected, and first named
in said return as Sheriff of the said County, and it appearing by the said
return from Talbot County, that Joseph Graham had the greatest number
of legal votes, and was duly elected and first named in said return, as
Sheriff of the said County. a Commission was this day issued to the said
Daniel Malot as Sheriff of Washington County, and to the said Joseph
Graham, as Sheriff of Talbot County.

Thursday November 28th 1833.
Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay James Mills
or order fifteen dollars for one quarter Cent of Magazine due the 3rd Instant.

Saturday November 30th 1833
Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Horstall,
Baethy & Berthoud or order two hundred and twenty dollars for books
purchased for the Library, under Resolution of the General Assembly, &
Certificate of the Librarian.

Thursday December 5th 1833
Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay
Brown, & Ken, or order one hundred and fifty two dollars to them
for balance due him for one quarter, along as Examiner General, for the
first of October last, after deducting the amount of fees received, in
account proved.
