

Wednesday October 14 1857

The Council met Present, the President, Messrs. [unclear] except Mr. Washington.

On the nomination of His Excellency the Governor and with the advice and consent of the Council, the following military appointments were made and commissions issued accordingly viz:

For the 1st Division

John H. Culbreth Inspector Vice Watkins appointed Assistant General

For the 4th Regiment, Albot County

Samuel Stevens Colonel

William H. Hayward Lieutenant Colonel

Theodore R. Lockerman Major

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay David Bridges or order four hundred dollars for examination of the public offices and collecting and arranging papers and documents, under Resolution no. 44 of the last General Assembly.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay John Sullivan or order thirteen dollars fifty cents for cleaning the old armory and packing away arms & in the gun house & amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay William Bishop or order three dollars for hauling arms, & amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay John M. Watkins or order twenty one dollars eighty seven cents for his expenses to Washington, by order of the Executive, in relation to arms due from the United States, & amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay John M. Watkins or order twenty nine dollars eighty seven cents for cleaning arms, in virtue of a resolution of the General Assembly, and six dollars for cleaning up old armory and packing arms by Henry Coulter, & amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay George F. Brewer or order one hundred and four cents for cleaning and repairing arms.
