

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay George Hughes or order seven hundred dollars on an account of expenses of a survey of the route for the Annapolis and Potomac Canal, to be accounted for.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay George McHughes or order fifteen hundred dollars for his services as engineer in making the survey of a route for the Annapolis and Potomac Canal & amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Washington G. Cook or order forty eight dollars twenty five cents, viz for expenses of firing five Salutes \$37.50, for taking off and putting on new Lock at the adjutant general's office \$5 cents, for repairing the State Flag \$2.50 for sheep skin and covering Sponges \$2, for repairing Gun House Lock, with plate \$1.50, for new bolt and putting on Window of Gun House \$1, and for repairing and putting in hand on some of the State House \$3, & amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Henry Thompson or order two Dollars eighty one cents for hauling wood from the Cellar to the front Dock and bringing it the same, & amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Julius Ducatel or order one hundred dollars for contingent expenses of the special Surveys, & amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Andrew Sheer or order nine dollars sixty two cents for Boxing and hauling & removing wood and carting dirt from the City at the Gun House, & amount allowed.
