

Tuesday April 11th 1837.

His Excellency the Governor granted a commutation of punishment to George Strowder, on account of an assault & Battery with intent to kill Noah Vincent, of which he was convicted in Kent County Court at March Term 1837, and for which he was sentenced to the Penitentiary for two years. (See Pardon Record).

Wednesday April 12th 1837.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Nathaniel H. Williams or order one hundred and twenty five dollars for one quarter's salary as a member of the Council and this day.

Friday April 14th 1837.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay John Courneil Hong or order eight hundred and three dollars fifty six cents, in part liquidation of the Bond of the State for \$4938.55, held by them and dated 14th of October 1834 and payable in six months after date.

Ordered that the Armory at Annapolis deliver to Captain George Bramwell or order fifty Rifles and accoutrements.

Saturday April 15th 1837.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay John N. William Murphy or order eight hundred dollars, on account of building new Boars Warehouse, to be accounted for.

Thursday April 20th 1837.

His Excellency the Governor granted the following Nolle Prosequis Viz

To Nick or Nicholas a free coloured man, on account of a charge of stealing a hog ^{and pig} which was pending against him by Indictment in Frederick County Court, and

To Paul, Slave of Dennis & Howard of the said County, on account of a charge of stealing a Hog and a Pig, which was pending against him by Indictment in Frederick County Court.

Monday April 24 1837.

His Excellency granted a Nolle Prosequi to Mary alias Fidelia Wilson, on account of a charge of stealing, upon which she had been committed to the Jail of Baltimore County.
