Whereas, by an act of the general assembly of this State entitled "An additional Supplement to an act entitled 'An act to amend and to regulate the Elections,' passed at December Session 1832, it is provided that the Election of Representatives from this State, to serve in the Congress of the United States, shall be made by the Citizens of this State, on the first Monday of October in the year one thousand eight hundred and thirty three, and on the same day in every second year thereafter; and that if at any time hereafter a special or extra session of Congress should be called, to convene at such period as it may be necessary,
