

Saturday June 17th 1837.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Andrew Slicer or order two hundred and two dollars and seventy cents for improvements made to the State House Hill under Resolution of the 21st of March 1837, as certified by R. W. Gill and Washington G. Tuck Superintendants.

Monday June 19th 1837.

His Excellency the Governor granted a Pardon to Thomas Gallighan or Gallahan, on account of Stealing to the amount of \$5, of which he was convicted in Baltimore City Court, at June Term 1836, and for which he was sentenced to the Penitentiary for two years; His Excellency also granted a Nolle Prosequi to

Henry A. Johnson (Mullatto) on account of a charge of Bigamy pending against him by indictment in Baltimore City Court, upon which he had been found guilty. (See Pardon Record).

Thursday June 22nd 1837.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Philip Clayton or order thirty dollars for white washing ceilings, cleaning stair work and colouring Walls of the Chamber and adjoining Committee room of the House of Delegates in agreement with Washington G. Tuck and Richard W. Gill Superintendants.

Wednesday June 28th 1837.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Charles F. Cloud or order fifty dollars for publishing in the Elkton Courier Sunday Lanes of December 1836, under Resolution of the General Assembly by direction of the Clerk of the Council.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Walter Ball or order two hundred dollars on account of painting the Dome of the State House as per Certificate of R. W. Gill and Washington G. Tuck, Superintendants.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay James M. Collins or order twenty eight dollars and eighty two cents for measuring the painter's work in the State House, incurred under Resolution of March 1835, as per Certificate of R. W. Gill & Washington G. Tuck, Superintendants.

Saturday July 1st 1837.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Henry Thompson or order one hundred and twelve dollars fifty cents for one quarter's salary as Messenger of the Council and for taking care of the State House &c, due this day.
