The following Demand, upon His Excellency William L. Marcy
Governor of the State of New York was made, upon the information and
evidence therein referred to viz.

To His Excellency William L. Marcy Governor of the State of
New York. Whereas James Burrows and James Miller alias
Leest, stand charged by affidavit with having entered and robbed the
Store of Aquila C. Hughes, in the City of Baltimore, of ~~the~~ property of
Watches and Jewelry, in the night of the twenty fifth of March last.

And Whereas information has been received at the Executive
Department of this State that the said James Burrows and James
Miller alias Leest, have fled from Justice, and been apprehended in
the City of New York, and that they are now in prison in said City, on
account of said offence. And it being important and highly necessary
for the good of Society, that the perpetrators of such offences should be
brought to Justice, Now therefore, I Thomas W. Peazey Governor
of Maryland, by virtue of the Authority vested in me by the Constitution
and Laws of the United States, do hereby (D E M A C Y) The
said James Burrows and James Miller, alias Leest, as fugitives
from the Justice of this State, and make known to your Excellency
that I have appointed Henry Thompson, Messenger of the Executive
Council, my agent to receive the said fugitive and bring him into this
State, having Jurisdiction of the offence charged against him, as aforesaid,
that he may be brought to trial therefor.

In Compliance with the requisitions of the Law, I herewith
annex and forward to your Excellency a copy of the affidavit upon
which this demand is founded: which I Certify is authentic.
