Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Richard G. Hutton or order two hundred dollars, in part for painting the Government House, & Contract, under Resolution of the General Assembly.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Samuel J. Gallahue or order twenty dollars for publications in the Village Herald of three Proclamations, by order of the Executive, & amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Samuel J. Gallahue or order one hundred and seven dollars for publications in the Village Herald by laws of 1835 & 1836, by direction of the Clerk of the Council under Resolutions of the General Assembly \$100, and the Proclamation of Congressional Election, as provided for by Law & amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay William H. - - - or order one hundred and twenty five dollars for one quarter salary as directed by the Council due the first ultimo.

Ordered that the Maps and drawings of the survey of a route for the Annapolis and Potomac Canal, be deposited in the State Library.

Ordered that Richard W. Gill and Washington G. Rich Esquires have a new pavement made at the South end of the State House.

Ordered that Andrew Miller and John Dwyer, who have the care of the public circle, keep all cattle and other beasts from trespassing thereon.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay George W. Hughes or order two hundred and eighty five dollars eighty cents, for balance due him on account of expenses of the survey of a route for the Annapolis and Potomac Canal, after deducting four thousand seven hundred dollars advanced on that account, under Resolution of the General Assembly, of amount allowed.
