

Eighty or two hundred dollars for transcribing an old Record &c.
by order of the Executive under Resolution of the General Assembly.

Monday August 21 1837.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Adam Ireland or order one hundred and thirteen dollars twenty three cents for furniture for the Court of Appeals Chamber, under Resolution of the General Assembly & Certificate of R. W. Gill & W. G. Tucker Superintendants.

Wednesday August 23^d 1837.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Cole & Co or order Sixty dollars for books furnished by them to the State Library by authority of the Joint Library Committee under Resolution of the General Assembly & Certificate of the Librarian.

Monday August 28 1837.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Elijah Wells or order one hundred and forty dollars for repairs in the Chamber of the Court of Appeals, as per Certificate of R. W. Gill and Washington G. Tucker Superintendants.

Thursday August 31 1837.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Richard G. Sutton or order three hundred and two dollars for balance due him for painting the Government House & Contract under Resolution of the General Assembly after deducting two hundred dollars advanced on that account & Certificate of R. W. Gill and Washington G. Tucker Superintendants.

Friday September 1 1837.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Alward & William Murphy or order three thousand dollars on account of building a New Tobacco Warehouse, under contract with the Executive, & authorized by Law, to be accounted for.

Saturday September 2 1837.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay David Ridge or order one hundred and two dollars, on account of transcribing a Record Book, by direction of the Governor and Council, under Resolution of the General Assembly.

Monday September 4 1837.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Richard Scrabb or order thirty seven dollars eighty five cents for one month's postage due the first Instant 1837 for the Executive \$30.75 for the Treasurer
