

The State of Maryland, to wit: Whereas, in compliance with a Demand of His Excellency Joseph Ritner Governor of the State of Pennsylvania, orders have been given for the surrender of a certain Johna Kopp as a fugitive from the Justice of the said State, to Adam Klingfelter Esquire, Sheriff of York County in said State, agent duly appointed to receive the said fugitive and transport him to the said State of Pennsylvania; it appearing from authentic documents transmitted to the Executive Department of this State, that the said Johna Kopp stands charged by indictment of the grand Inquest of the said State, inquiring for the body of the said County, of York, with having, ~~on the~~ first day of April last, at the County aforesaid, committed fornication with a certain Rebecca Thomas, and then and there begotten a male bastard child upon her body, contrary to the act of the General Assembly of the said State, in such case made and provided, &c. Now therefore, I Thomas M. Nease, Governor of the State of Maryland, do hereby require and enjoin all persons within this State, to let the said Adam Klingfelter agent as aforesaid pass with the said fugitive unmolested to the said State of Pennsylvania: he the said agent conducting himself in a peaceable and orderly manner, and using no improper severity or cruelty in his treatment of the said prisoner.

The following Demand was made upon the Honorable William Cranch, Chief Judge of the Circuit Court of the District of Columbia, for the person therein named as a fugitive from Justice, upon application and the information and evidence therein mentioned. Viz.

To the Honorable William Cranch, Chief Judge of the Circuit Court of the District of Columbia.

Whereas John Grimes stands charged by Presentment of the grand Inquest of the State of Maryland for the body of Prince Georges County, with stealing one dark Bay Horse, the property of Benjamin E. Gault. And Whereas, information has been received at the Executive Department of this State, that the said John Grimes hath fled from Justice, and has been apprehended and is now in Jail in the District of Columbia. And it being important and highly necessary for the good of Society, that the perpetrators of such offences should be brought to justice.
