Monday October 23rd 1837.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay John Bacon Treasurer of the Pennsylvania Institution for the Deaf & Dumb or to his order one thousand and sixty six dollars nineteen cents for half year's tuition, support of indigent Deaf & Dumb pupils of the State, as authorized by Law up to the first instant, pursuant and draft.

Tuesday October 24th 1837.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay John Little or order ten dollars for one year's subscription to the Law Library, by authority of the Joint Library Committee, under Resolution of the General Assembly, & certificate of the Librarian.
