

Thursday October 26th 1837.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay James W. Welch or
or over five dollars for publishing Proclamation of Congressional Election, for and

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Henry Thompson
or over fifty three dollars thirty five Cents for the purchase of firewood, to be accounted for.

Saturday October 28 1838

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay John Hall or
over one hundred and twenty seven dollars for Chairs for the Court of
Appeals Chamber, under Resolution of the General Assembly of March last. By

Tuesday October 31 1837.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay John R. P.
William Murphy or to their order six thousand dollars, on account of
building a new Tobacco Warehouse, under contract with the Executive,
as authorized by Law, to be accounted for.

Thursday Nov. 2nd 1837.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Jacob Cook
or over one hundred dollars, on account of expenses incurred by him in
apprehending and bringing two fugitives from Justice from Philadelphia,
to Baltimore - to be accounted for.

Juan Federico Strohm of the City of Baltimore having this day
produced to His Excellency the Governor and Exequatur from the President
of the United States recognizing him as Consul of the Republic of Venezuela
for the Port of Baltimore, in this State - His Excellency ordered that the
said act of recognition be published for the information of all whom it
may concern. The following is the Order issued by His Excellency.

The State of Maryland, To all whom it may concern.
JUAN FEDERICO STROHM, ~~presented~~ produced to me an Exequatur signed
by the President of the United States, and sealed with the Seal of the said
State, recognizing him as Consul of the Republic of Venezuela for the
Port of Baltimore, in this State, ordered that the said Recognition
be published for the information and Government of the people of this State.
Given under my hand and the Great Seal of the State
of Maryland this second day of November in the year
of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty seven.
