S. Bryan, on a count of assault & battery on James White, for which he
was convicted in Queen Anne's County Court at November Term Instant

Tuesday November 21 1837.

The following Orders were issued for the surrender of the
person therein named as a fugitive from Justice, upon the Demand
and information and evidence therein referred to. (Viz.)

The State of Maryland, To the Warden of the Jail of Baltimore
County, Greeting: Whereas it appears from authentic documents, certified
and transmitted to the Executive Department of this State, by His Excellency
Peirce M. Butler Governor of the State of South Carolina, that a certain
Thomas Thrustand alias Simpson, stands charged by the affidavit of J.
Robinson Cashier of the Planters and Mechanics Bank of South Carolina
with having on the sixth day of May last, passed on the said Planters & Mechanics
Bank two forged checks, knowing them to be forgeries, amounting in the
whole to twenty six thousand eight hundred and ninety seven dollars
and fifty cents, and that the said Thrustand alias Simpson has fled
from the Justice of the said State and is now confined in the County
Jail of Baltimore County. And whereas the said Peirce M. Butler
Governor as aforesaid, hath, in pursuance of the Authority given in such
cases by the Constitution and Laws of the United States, demanded
the said Thomas Thrustand alias Simpson of the Executive of this State
as a fugitive from Justice, and appointed Alexander H. Wilson his agent
