Wednesday December 13th 1837.

His Excellency the Governor this day granted a ~~Volle Pardon~~ to Solomon Stanford, negro, on account of a charge of Stealing which was pending against him by Indictment in Caroline County Court. (See Pardon Record).

Friday December 15th 1837.

His Excellency the Governor this day granted a ~~Pardon~~ ~~Pardon~~ to Samuel Hall, negro, on account of Felony of which he was convicted in Baltimore City Court, at February Term 1837, and for which he was sentenced to the Penitentiary for two years. (See Pardon Record).

Thursday December 21 1837.
