

of punishment, and if the said William Wheeler does not give his consent to such execution of punishment, then and in that event you are hereby required and commanded, that on or before 12 of the Clock on Friday the fifth of June next, you take the said William Wheeler from your Prison, and him safely convey to the Gallows in the County aforesaid, the place of the execution of Malefactors, and there the said William Wheeler hang by the neck until he be dead. For all which this shall be your sufficient power and Authority.
