The Governor this day in virtue of the power vested in
him by the 4th Sect. of the Act of Dec. Session 1845 Ch. 203
fixed the Commission of Henry Derries the Collector of the
State tax for Carroll County for the years 1842 & 1846 at
ten per cent. The said Derries having been appointed
by him the Collector for those years in default of the
qualification of a Collector under the appointment
of the Jury Court.
