

June 8<sup>th</sup> 1847

The Gov. this day in obedience to a requisition from the Governor of Pennsylvania issued a warrant for the apprehension & delivery (to David M<sup>r</sup> Nutt) agent) of Samuel Smith who stands charged upon the affidavit of Elizabeth Kennedy with the crime of Fornication & Bastardy.

June 18<sup>th</sup> 1847

The Governor this day upon the recommendations of the Judges of Baltimore City Court granted a pardon to Addison (whom convicted in said Court at May Term 1847 of Larceny & sentenced to the Penitentiary) — see record of pardons —

June 21<sup>st</sup> 1847

The Governor this day refused to issue a *Wolfe Prosequi* to Negro Perry Doyle of Frederick County charged with stealing a watch the property of Robert Downey.

June 28<sup>th</sup> 1847

The Governor this day upon the recommendations of the Directors of the Md. Penitentiary & the Hon. Judges Spence granted a pardon to John Roberts who was convicted in Caroline County Court at March Term 1842 of Murder in the 2<sup>d</sup> Degree & sentenced to the Penitentiary) — see record of pardons

July the 15<sup>th</sup> 1847

The Gov. this day upon the requisition of the Governor of Pennsylvania issued a warrant to the Sheriff of Balt. City for the apprehension of Tho<sup>s</sup> Dull a fugitive from justice in that State, who stands charged on indictment in the Court of Quarter Sessions of Philadelphia with the crime of Larceny. The said fugitive to be delivered to M<sup>r</sup> Smith the Agent for that purpose named in the said Requisition.

July the 28<sup>th</sup> 1847

The Governor this day upon the recommendations of the Hon. Judge Marshall of Frederick C<sup>y</sup> & the Directors of the Md. Penitentiary granted a pardon to Levi Henry convicted in Frederick County Court at Dec<sup>r</sup> Term 1832 of the crime of Rape & sentenced to the Penitentiary for 15 years — see record of pardons

July 29<sup>th</sup> 1847

The Gov. this day upon the recommendations of Judge Crain remitted forty of a fine of fifty dollars imposed by Charles County Court at July Term 1847 upon B. M. Hart for buying & disseminating a claim against the County.
