Proclamation
Thomas G. Pratt Governor of Maryland
To all whom these presents may concern
Whereas there is a void from the Judges of Election in this annual Convention of this State and of the City of Baltimore as members of an election held on Wednesday the 10th day of October 1847 for members to represent this State in the Congress of the United States and have carefully examined the number of votes given for every person voted for as such - Now therefore in pursuance of the law in such case made and provided, I do by this Proclamation
