To the Senate.

I respectfully make the following nominations: For clerk of Prince Georges County Court. John D. Brooke.

January 7th 1848.

This day the Governor received a communication from the Senate informing him that the Senate advised and consented to the appointment of John D. Brooke as clerk of Prince Georges County Court; and thereupon the Governor issued a commission to the said John D. Brooke to be clerk as aforesaid.

The Governor received the following communication from the House of Delegates.
By the House of Delegates January 6th 1848.

Ordered. That the Governor be requested to cause the national flag to be displayed, at the top of the State House steeple on Saturday the 8th of the present month; and an appropriate salute fired at noon at the same day in commemoration of the victory achieved over the British forces at New Orleans on the 8th of January 1815.

You are hereby ordered, to cause the National Flag to be displayed at the top of the State House steeple and an appropriate salute to be fired at noon on Saturday the 8th of the present month in commemoration of the victory achieved on the 8th of January 1815. as requested by the order of the House of Delegates of the 6th.
