

February 19th 1848.

This day the Governor issued the following order to the Adjutant General.

Adjutant General M. M.

Sir. Under Resolution N^o 27 of 1832, You will cause to be fired on the 22nd of Feb. inst the Anniversary of the birth day of Gen George Washington, a Federal salute at Sunrise, a National salute at Noon and a Federal salute at sunset, at each point as no inconvenience may be sustained by the citizens of Annapolis. You will also cause the National Flag to be displayed at the top of the dome of the State House throughout the day.

The Governor sent to the Senate a list of general nominations of civil appointments for the State at large.

The Governor received the official Bond of R. T. Cowman, Notary Public at Annapolis and approved the same.

The Governor received a communication from the Senate informing him that that body advised and consented to the appointment of the list of civil Officers nominated by him on the 17th inst for Caroline County. Whereupon commissions were issued to the civil Officers appointed for the said County.

February 21st 1848.

The Governor this day nominated to the Senate the list of civil appointments for Carroll County.

The Governor nominated to the Senate John O. Wharton and Samuel Dickins as Lottery Commissioners.

The Governor nominated to the Senate an additional list of civil appointments for Prince Georges County containing the Tobacco Inspectors for the Tobacco Warehouses in the said County.

February 22nd 1848.

The Governor this day issued a requisition to the Governor of Virginia for the apprehension and delivery up of Obadiah A. Downer a fugitive from justice, who stands charged on the oath of George Brown and William T. Hoblitzell with obtaining a valuable security by fraud and false pretences.
