

Martin Troh and John Fable of T. as commissioners of the Tax, Abraham Lammoth and John Mahorn as justices of the District Court, and Jacob Schaeffer as Justice of the Peace to whose appointment the Senate refused to advise or consent. And that the Senate advised and consented to the appointment of James O. McCormick as Inspector of Liquors in the City of Baltimore.

March 8th 1848

The Governor this day nominated to the Senate the commissioners of Loans and of Stamps; the Chief Inspector of Salted Fish; the weigher of Hay and Straw at the Western Scales; an additional Inspector of Flour; and the weigher of Live Stock in the City of Baltimore.

The Governor nominated to the Senate John T. Hunt as a Justice of the Peace in Kent County.

The Governor received the Official Bond of Thomas Croft appointed the weigher of Hay and Straw at the Eastern Scales in Baltimore City and approved the same.

March 9th 1848.

The Governor this day nominated to the Senate a Lumber Inspector at Chesapeake City in Cecil County.

The Governor received the Official Bond of David W. Hudson appointed Notary Public in Baltimore City and approved the same.

The Governor nominated to the Senate certain Military Officers for the 19th and 48th Regiments of Maryland Militia.

The Governor nominated to the Senate a list of Civil Officers for Carroll and Frederick Counties in place of those whose nominations had been heretofore rejected by the Senate.

March 10th 1848.

The Governor this day nominated to the Senate an additional list of Civil Officers for Baltimore and Prince Georges Counties; Thomas P. Fglehart Inspector of Tobacco at Warehouse No. 5. in Baltimore City; and sundry persons residents of other States commissioners to take acknowledgment of Deeds and instrument of writing under seal out of the State of Maryland.

The Governor nominated to the Senate Robert Aitken vice Robert J. Aiken erroneously nominated as Justice of the Peace for the 1st District in Baltimore City.

The Governor nominated to the Senate John Miller as an additional Justice of the Peace for Somerset County.
