

The Governor appointed and commissioned Jacob M. Kunkel Esquire of Frederick County one of his Aid de Camps with rank of Colonel.

March 20th 1848.

The Governor this day appointed and commissioned Henry Myers Justice of the Peace for the Fifth District in the City of Baltimore vice Elias Ware Jr resigned.

The Governor appointed and commissioned a Justice of the Peace and a Justice of the District Court in Frederick County. Three Justices of the District Court and three Justices of the Peace in Charles County. A Justice of the District Court and two Justices of the Peace in Carroll County. A Justice of the Peace in Montgomery County. And two Justices of the Peace in Allegany County.

March 22nd 1848.

The Governor this day received the Official Bonds of Edward Coker appointed Gauger, and of John McPherson appointed Inspector General of Flour in Baltimore City and approved the same.

The Governor in compliance with a resolution of the General Assembly transmitted to the Governor of each of the several States of the Union a copy of the resolution approving Mr Whitney's plan for the construction of a Rail Road to the Pacific Ocean.

The Governor transmitted to each of the Representatives in the United States Congress from the State of Maryland a copy of the Resolution of the General Assembly relative to erection of a Monument in honor of the memory of Baron De Kalb at the City of Annapolis.

March 23rd 1848.

The Governor this day received the Official Bond of Cesar A. Grant appointed Inspector of Tobacco in Baltimore City and approved the same.

The Governor transmitted to each of the Representatives in the United States Congress from the State of Maryland a copy of the Resolution of the General Assembly relative to the plan of Mr Whitney for connecting the Atlantic and Pacific oceans by a Rail Road.

March 24th 1848.

The Governor this day appointed and commissioned Alexander S. Evans a Justice of the Peace for Somerset County vice William S. Dashiell resigned.

The Governor transmitted to each of the Maryland Representatives in the United States Congress a copy of the Resolution of the General Assembly relative to the improvement of the harbour of Havre de Grace.
