

April 12th 1848.

The Governor this day pardoned Hester Tippet a free negro convicted in St. Marys County Court of felony and recommended to Executive clemency by Judge Key and other respectable citizens of said County.

The Governor received and approved the Official Bonds of Jacob Deam an Assistant Inspector of Flour in Baltimore, and of Bennett Drace a Gascon in the said City.

The Governor appointed and commissioned John D. Kidd Justice of the Peace for Baltimore County vice John Dooley of Gas resigned.

The Governor issued the following order to the Adjutant General.

You will make requisition on the Ordnance Department at Washington for 60 Sabres, 60 pistols and 60 pair of holsters as a part of the States quota of Arms for the years 1847 and 1848, for a troop of Horse commanded by Capt. G. W. B. Boulden called the "Independent Light Dragoons."

April 14th 1848.

The Governor this day appointed and commissioned Alexander Norris Chief Justice and Charles D. Bouldin as an Associate Justice of the Orphans Court of Harford County.

April 15th 1848.

The Governor this day appointed and commissioned Arthur Ganey as Chief Justice of the District Court of the North District in Frederick County vice John H. Worthington resigned.

The Governor appointed and commissioned William C. Decker Justice of the Peace vice Philip Lanter resigned and El Coulson a Justice of the Peace vice Robert Evans resigned in Cecil County.

April 17th 1848.

The Governor this day remitted the forfeited recognizances of James W. Tylehart entered into for the appearance of Joseph Whittington at the April Term 1847 of Anne Arundel County Court.
