

April 24th 1848.

The Governor this day appointed and commissioned John H. Long well Major, Charles Gilpin Adjutant, Dr. J. Thorb Surgeon, Dr. Francis Thomas Davis Surgeon Mate, William Fisher Paymaster, David Gantio Quartermaster and Rev. James Pearce Chaplain, of the 2nd Regiment of 1st Regimental Cavalry District Maryland Militia; He also appointed and commissioned John W. Watus Captain and George D. Gowan 1st Lieut of 2nd Regiment Maryland Militia. He also appointed and commissioned Allen Marriott 1st Lieut and Stephen Beard Jun 2nd Lieut in Captain Sgharts Company in 2nd Regiment of Maryland Militia. The Governor also appointed and commissioned Owen Disney Captain and Joshua Disney 1st Lieut of Company No. 9 in the 2nd Regiment Maryland Militia.

The Governor appointed and commissioned Francis D. Gotten County Surveyor in Cecil County vice Steele resigned.

The Governor appointed and commissioned Albert C. Ainsworth Commissioner to take the acknowledgment of Deeds &c to be used in this State residing in the State of Louisiana.

The Governor appointed and commissioned William Pinkney Whyte as one of his Aid de Camps with the rank of Colonel.

May 1st 1848.

The Governor this day appointed and commissioned Samuel Gaste as Colonel, Lungan Doteler as Lieut Colonel and David Karler as Major of the 28th Regiment of Maryland Militia. He also appointed and commissioned Richard Lilly as Captain Jacob Grop 1st Lieut, George Reppart 2nd Lieut, David Street 3rd Lieut and Joseph Carter Ensign in the 5th Regiment of Volunteer Infantry. He also appointed and commissioned Joseph Long 1st Lieut, William Phibbot 2nd Lieut, Jacob Reedy 3rd Lieut and Daniel Smith Ensign, of the Independent Guards in 2nd Battalion 28th Regiment Maryland Militia, a Company commanded by Captain Rhinehart.

The Governor appointed and commissioned Henry Ward and Robert H. Corbin Justices of the Peace in Somerset County vice Stevens and Burnett resigned. He also appointed and commissioned Thomas M. Porter and Hugh McWhirren Justices of the Peace in Allegany County vice Jno M. Porter and Chas. Triggs resigned. And the Governor also appointed and commissioned John W. Rutledge Chief Justice of the Orphans Court in Harford County vice Norris resigned.

The Governor appointed and commissioned Dr. James Higgins of Anne Arundel County Agricultural Chemist for this State.
