

The Governor this day appointed and commissioned Thomas D. Beall and Richard D. Walker Justices of the District Court of the first District of Prince George's County vice Carroll and Edmondson resigned.

The Governor appointed and commissioned William A. Horn Ensign in Capt Geo A. Conder's Company attached to the 20th Regiment Maryland Militia.

The Governor remitted the forfeited recognizance of George Thomas Free negro of St. Marys County on the recommendation of numerous citizens of said County.

May 4th 1848.

The Governor this day passed an order for the admission of John Handy Simmons an indigent Deaf mute as a State's pupil into the Pennsylvania Institution for the deaf and dumb, on the recommendation of the Commissioners of Worcester County.

The Governor appointed and commissioned George Conway Commissioner to take the acknowledgment of Deeds &c in the State of Alabama residing at Mobile. Francis Wharton Commissioner of Deeds residing at Philadelphia and Robert D. Johnson Commissioner of Deed residing at Galveston Texas.

May 5th 1848.

The Governor this day appointed and commissioned Samuel Alexander Luckey Justice of the Peace in Allegany County vice Peter Yeast resigned. He also appointed and commissioned James Smith (P.C.) Justice of the Peace for Dorchester County vice Moses L. Keene resigned.

The Governor on the recommendation of numerous citizens of Anne Arundel County and on the petition of Richard J. Turner remanded the said Turner from Anne Arundel County jail to Baltimore County and City jail to serve out the term of seven years in the said jail. The said Turner was indicted in Baltimore City Court for conspiracy to defraud the Mechanics Bank, his trial was removed to the Anne Arundel County Court and at April Term 1848 was tried convicted and sentenced to confinement Anne Arundel County jail for seven years and he is now sent back to Baltimore City and County jail to serve out the said terms.

May 6th 1848.

The Governor this day appointed and commissioned James Cassidy Justice of the Peace in Washington County vice Abraham Hull resigned.

The Governor appointed and commissioned James W. Warren Auctioneer in the City of Baltimore.
