

The Governor on the recommendation of Queen Anne County Court remitted the fine imposed on Thomas Downing for selling spirituous liquor without license.

The Governor appointed and commissioned James P. Russell Justice of the Peace in Dorchester County vice Solomon Russell erroneously commissioned.

The Governor issued an order for the admission of Levin Taylor an indigent deaf mute of Dorchester County into the Pennsylvania Institution for the Deaf and Dumb, as a pupil to be supported by the State of Maryland.

May 13th 1848.

The Governor this day appointed and commissioned Charles McColister as Captain, and W. H. C. Olden as 2nd Lieut in Company C. in 35th Regiment M. M. and Samuel Rolph 1st Lieut in Company E of 35th Regiment of Maryland Militia.

May 15th 1848.

The Governor this day on the recommendation of numerous citizens, remitted the fine imposed on Charles A. Brim by Worcester County Court for selling spirituous liquor without a license; he also remitted the fine imposed on Isiah D. Shepherd by Allegany County Court for keeping a Billiard Table without a license.

May 16th 1848.

The Governor this day appointed and commissioned Thomas Lord Chief Justice of the District Court of the second District of Harford County vice William Minphy resigned.

The Governor on the recommendation of a number of respectable citizens of Frederick County granted a Pardon to Jos. H. Miller convicted of Forgery in Frederick County Court and sentenced to the Penitentiary at February Term 1847.

The Governor appointed and commissioned Arnold C. Ballard as Inspector of Lumber in Baltimore City vice John Talbot resigned.

The Governor received a requisition from the Governor of Pennsylvania for the apprehension and delivery up of Andrew Lehman who is charged with the crime of fornication and a fugitive from justice; Whereupon the Governor issued his warrant to the Sheriff of Allegany County for the arrest of the said fugitive and his surrender to the agent of the State of Pennsylvania.

May 17th 1848.

The Governor this day appointed and commissioned George W. Mitchell Captain in the 38th Regiment of M. M. vice Joseph McMullen declined.

The Governor appointed and commissioned George B. Jontz Justice of the District Court of 4th District in Baltimore County vice Melcher Abner resigned.
