

May 23rd 1848.

The Governor this day appointed and commissioned Samuel Teabright 1st Lieut vice Gordon resigned, George Davis 2nd Lieut vice Ruddack resigned, and Charles Askew 3rd Lieut vice Smith resigned in the company called the "Chesapeake Riflemen" in the 1st Regiment of Baltimore Riflemen.

May 24th 1848.

The Governor this day appointed and commissioned George W. Wilson Captain in the 17th Regiment M. M. vice Henry M. Murray removed from the Regimental District.

May 25th 1848.

The Governor this day appointed and commissioned William Foster as Captain, Lewis Parsons as 1st Lieut, Edward R. Sparks as 2nd Lieut, and Ira Lipton as 3rd Lieut in the company called the "Hereford Greys" attached to the 1st Independent Volunteer Regiment 11th Brigade M. M.

The Governor also appointed and commissioned George A. Parker as Captain, Charles W. Lingle as 1st Lieut and Stephen R. Franklin 2nd Lieut in the Extra Battalion M. M. in Worcester County. He also appointed and commissioned John M. Armstrong Jr 1st Lieut vice C. J. Scott resigned, John Newman 2nd Lieut vice O. F. Sutton resigned in the company at Georgetown Cross Roads attached to the 2nd Battalion 33rd Regiment Maryland Militia.

May 26th 1848.

The Governor this day appointed and commissioned John L. Dorch as 2nd Lieut in Capt John L. Johnson's company in 1st Regiment M. M.

May 31st 1848.

The Governor this day appointed and commissioned Daniel C. Biggs as 1st Lieut and Charles E. Stewart as 2nd Lieut in Company No 9 commanded by Capt Geo Wilson in 17th Regiment M. M. He also appointed and commissioned William F. Hamilton Adjutant 24th Regiment M. M. vice Catron removed from the State. And James M. Anderson Major 53rd Regiment Maryland Volunteer Infantry vice Miliken resigned. And George Rhinehart Major in 28th Regiment M. M. vice Hailey declined. And J. H. Swain Captain of Potapoco Riflemen attached to 1st Rifle Regiment M. V. And Elsha Cox 1st Lieut "Columbian Riflemen" 1st Rifle Regiment M. V.

The Governor appointed and commissioned Thomas M. Camden and Samuel Gott Justices of the Peace in Anne Arundel County vice Charles A. Waters and Benjamin Luby resigned.

The Governor appointed and commissioned Charles McCallister Justice of the 2nd District Court in Queen Anne's County vice Mof declined.
