

The Governor issued the following order to the Adjutant General of the State of Maryland.

Head Quarters M. M.
Annapolis Feb 5th 1849.

Sir.

You will, immediately upon the receipt of this, issue a cautionary order to Col Davies of the 53rd Regiment and Col Hickman of the 5th Regiment, Maryland Volunteer Infantry, to hold themselves in readiness to detail from their respective commands, in aid of the civil authorities, such force as may be deemed necessary by the Attorney General to prevent and suppress an unlawful and tumultuous meeting about to be held at Poole's Island, in the State of Maryland.

February 6th 1849.

The Governor this day issued an order for the admission of Sarah E. Morgan, a deaf mute of the City of Baltimore, as a State pupil into the Pennsylvania Institution for the Instruction of the Deaf and Dumb.

The Governor this day appointed and commissioned Alfred B. Ely, Commissioner of Deeds to reside at Boston Massachusetts.

February 8th 1849.

The Governor this day issued an order for the admission of Susan Ann Weyvill a deaf mute of Prince Georges County into the Pennsylvania Institution for the Instruction of the Deaf and Dumb as a pupil of the State of Maryland.

February 9th 1849.

The Governor this day appointed and commissioned Henry C. Rawlings an Associate Justice of the Orphans Court in Caroline County vice Thomas A. Turner resigned.

The Governor appointed and commissioned Samuel G. Smith Trustee of the Poor in Caroline County vice Peter Johnson removed from the County. The appointment was made under the provisions of the Act of 1831. Chap 226.

The Governor issued the following requisition to the Governor of the State of Pennsylvania for the apprehension and delivery up of certain fugitives from justice,

Philip Francis Thomas Governor of the State of Maryland.
