

May 23rd 1849

The Governor this day upon the receipt of the requisition of the Governor of South Carolina for the apprehension and delivery of James Cauley charged with the crime of larceny issued his warrant to the Warden of the jail for Baltimore city & county, directing him to deliver said James Cauley to Ross Sprigg Esquire the Agent appointed by the Governor of South Carolina to receive him and take him to that state.

May 24th 1849

The Governor this day appointed and commissioned Samuel J. Mills 1st Lt. Independent Blues 5th Regt. U. S. Art. vice Shepard Jr. resigned; also appointed and commissioned John C. Holland 2nd Lt. of same Company vice Mills promoted; also appointed and commissioned Daniel C. B. Kirtley 3rd of same Company vice Holland promoted; also appointed and commissioned William S. Hendley Ensign of same Company vice Spelman resigned; also appointed and commissioned Henry E. Batts 1st Lt. Manchester Regt. 15th Regt. M. M. vice Garner removed; and also appointed and commissioned Lewis H. Steiner Surgeon's mate 16th Regt. M. M. vice J. E. Bantz removed

May 25th 1849

The Governor this day appointed and commissioned William Butler vice William Batters (erroneously named in former Commission for William Butler) a Justice of the peace in and for Baltimore County.

The Governor appointed and commissioned George Hale Surveyor of Kent County vice said Hale having failed to apply for his Commission as required by the Act of 1847 ch. 54 sec. 2.

The Governor rejected the application of the Council of Conrad Butler also Conrad bases for the commutation of the sentence of death to confinement in the penitentiary.

May 26th 1849

The Governor this day appointed and commissioned George Lott Riser Captain Cavalry 1st Regimental Cavalry District M. M.; also appointed and commissioned James Willis 1st Lt. of same Company and also appointed and commissioned Francis A. Hoffman 2nd Lt. of same Company.

May 29th 1849

The Governor this day appointed and commissioned Daniel Bowley Commissioner to take the acknowledgement of deeds in and for the State of New York vice Thos. Jeff. Smith resigned.

May 30th 1849

The Governor this day appointed and commissioned John Dutton Inspector of Linc in the city of Baltimore vice Elijah Hutton resigned

The Governor issued a warrant to the Sheriff of Alleghany County commanding him to arrest a certain Emanuel Oster charged with the crime of larceny and to deliver him to Andrew J. Snively the Agent appointed for that purpose
