

of Baltimore city pardoned. Owen Jones arrested at May Term 1847 of Baltimore City Court of the crime of Burglary and sentenced to be confined in the penitentiary from the 28th May 1847 to 28th May 1852.

The Governor upon the receipt of information that George Reynolds a fugitive from the justice of Pennsylvania for whose arrest he had on the 15th instant issued his warrant to the Sheriff of Wiltshire County, was now confined in the jail of Frederick County, issued his warrant to the Sheriff of Frederick County commanding him to deliver the said George Reynolds to John M. Fisher the Agent of the State of Pennsylvania appointed to receive him.

The Governor upon the recommendation of Henry Damall and other respectable citizens of Anne Arundel County granted a *Volle Pledge* to Dick Purley slave of Mrs Susan Sellman of said County charged with the crime of stealing a horse the property of the said Henry Damall upon condition that the said Dick Purley be sold beyond the limits of the State as a slave for life.

Oct. 22nd 1849

The Governor this day appointed and commissioned William Morrison a justice of the peace for Prince Georges County vice J. M. Capron removed from the County.

Oct. 23rd 1849

The Governor this day appointed and commissioned Jacob Fichtig a justice of the peace of Alleghany County vice William Taylor deceased.

The Governor appointed and commissioned Columbus E. Cook an Auctioneer to reside in the city of Baltimore vice R. Meacham who failed to apply for his Commission as required by law.

The Governor appointed and commissioned Dr. John Reid a justice of the peace for Frederick County vice John P. Harroff who refused to qualify and also appointed and commissioned Peter Rhodes a justice of the peace for same County vice James E. Wood deceased.

The Governor this day issued the following Proclamations:
State of Maryland Court:

Whereas it is not only proper and consistent with the sacred duties of a people to the Supreme Being, but it has been customary for the Executive of this State to assign annually a day to be observed by her citizens as a day of public worship, prayer and Thanksgiving to Almighty God for the civil and religious privileges and blessings which they have individually and nationally enjoyed during the year
