20th March 1850

The Governor this day appointed and commissioned Geo. Lewis Little chief justice of district court No 3 of Carroll County vice Samuel Meisinger deceased.

The Governor has received the bonds of the following foraries public town Richard J. Gorman of Annapolis, William Hobbs of Cumberland, Charles Cole of Frederick and Joseph D. Williams of Baltimore city and also the bond of John Satterfield Amos at Easton.

The Governor appointed and commissioned Arthur M. Loverton justice of the peace of Caroline County vice Eliza Barker resigned.

21st March 1850

The Governor appointed and commissioned Daniel Lutz 1st Lieutenant, Andrew Hendrick 2nd Lieutenant and George Puhl 3rd Lieutenant of Captain Guards attached to the 8th Regiment M. C. Co.

25th March 1850

The Governor this day appointed and commissioned Henry P. Lockett, Patrick O'Neill and Michael Byrne visitors of St. John's Literary Institution Frederick under resolution No 1 of 1832.

The Governor appointed and commissioned George S. Melan Commissioner to take the acknowledgement of deed to to reside in California.

29th March 1850

The Governor this day transmitted to the Senators and delegates in Congress of this State the resolution of the legislature in relation to the monument to the memory of Aaron B. Hall, that in relation to the light boats on the Seven foot Knoll and on flat Cap and that in relation to the light boat at James Island bar.

It appears by the annexed papers duly authenticated according to the laws of this State that a certain Albert M.
