

the State of Maryland, in obedience to the requirements of the said act of Assembly, do by this my proclamation, order and direct that an election be held in the several counties, counties, towns and districts and the city of Baltimore, on the first Wednesday of September next for delegates to a convention to frame a new Constitution and form of Government for this State in such manner and under such regulations as are provided in said act of Assembly.

Given under my hand and the Great Seal of the State of Maryland at the city of Annapolis, on this twelfth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty.

12th June 1850

The Governor this day upon the recommendation of Judge Keblett remitted the forfeited recognizance entered into by Mary Johnson for her appearance before Baltimore city Court to answer to an indictment for felony.

13th June 1850

The Governor this day remitted the fine of twenty dollars imposed upon Benjamin H. Mulliken by the Magistrate's Court of 3^d election District of Prince Georges County for an assault and battery upon Thomas W. Clafett.

24th June 1850

The Governor this day upon the recommendation of many respectable citizens of Washington County remitted the fine of fifty dollars imposed upon John Churchill by Washington County Court on conviction at Nov. Term 1849 for an assault and battery.

The Governor upon the recommendation of many respectable citizens pardoned Nathaniel Reed (col'd) convicted in Cecil County Court at October Term 1845 of Stealing and sentenced to be confined in the penitentiary for five years.
