Eder stands with the crime of obtaining goods under false pretences committed within the city of Baltimore in said State and it has been represented to me that he has fled from the presence of this State and has taken refuge within the State of New York

And therefore pursuant to the provisions of the Constitution and Laws of the United States in such case made and provided I do hereby request that the said Phaul M. Eder be apprehended and delivered to Archibald G. Ridgely who is hereby duly authorized to receive and convey him to the State of Maryland that he be dealt with according to Law.
