23rd Sept: 1850

The Governor this day appointed and commissioned *Samuel Briggs* Captain,
Emery Jordan 1st Lieutenant and *James C. Parks* 2nd Lieutenant of 63rd Regiment
Mainland Militia in Capt. *J. Briggs* company and also appointed and commissioned
Richard France, Captain, *George M. Hering*, 1st Lieutenant *Thomas Brown* 2nd Lieutenant
and *Samuel Blom* 3rd Lieutenant of "Law Regt" of 5th Regiment M. V.

24th Sept: 1850

The Governor this day appointed *Ross Minard*, *J. B. Latrobe*, *Amos Capron*
Charles B. Calvert, *Walter Perkins*, *Amos A. Cambell*, *James Williams*, *William*
Hamman, *Doct. Tho. Edmundson*, *Samuel Methuen*, *Alan Ernie Davis*, *Major George*
Peter and *George Washington Legg* Jr. a committee at the request of the Central Authority
at Washington created according to the regulations adopted by the Royal Commissioners,
to select from such articles of American art and industry as may be submitted by
citizens of this State for admission at the Industrial Exhibition to be held in London
in May 1851; and to Co. operate for such purpose with said Central Authority
at Washington and have this day notified them respectively of their appointment.

26th Sept: 1850

The Governor this day issued the following requisition:
State of Maryland, to-wit:

Philip Francis Thomas Governor of the State of Maryland

To His Excellency, the Governor of Indiana

It appears by the annexed papers duly authenticated
according to the laws of this State that a certain William Mitchell otherwise called William G.
Mitchell stands charged with the crime of murder committed in the County of Alleghany in
said State of Maryland and it has been represented to me that he has fled from the justice
of this State and has taken refuge within the State of Indiana

And therefore pursuant to the provisions of the Constitution and laws of the
United States in such case made and provided I do hereby request that the said
William Mitchell otherwise called William G. Mitchell be apprehended and
delivered to the Jail a strip of this State who is hereby duly authorized to
receive and convey him to the State of Maryland there to be dealt with according
to law.

In witness whereof I have hereunto affixed my name and the
Great Seal of the State this twenty sixth day of September in the
year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty.
