

5th November 1850

The Governor upon the recommendation of the Directors of the Maryland Penitentiary and Warden thereof pardoned John Penny convicted of felony at Sept. 11. Term 1846 of Baltimore City Court and sentenced to be confined in the Penitentiary until 2nd April 1857

6th November 1850

The Governor this day remitted the interest on the accounts of John S. Enos Collector in Baltimore County for the year 1845 and 1846 because of the omission of the Treasury to credit him with a sum of money which exclusive of interest more than paid them off.

7th November 1850

The Governor this day appointed and commissioned Joseph Thomas a Commissioner of Deeds to reside in Philadelphia, also appointed and commissioned Walter M. Underhill and John Phelps Commissioners of Deeds to reside in New York, and also appointed and commissioned George C. Thomas a Commissioner of Deeds to reside in Washington D.C.

9th November 1850

The Governor this day appointed and commissioned John Henry Gray Mudd a Commissioner of Deeds to reside in the State of California

14th November 1850

The Governor this day appointed and commissioned Park Dubehart 2nd Lt. of Junior Artillerists Company A attached to 1st Light Brigade 1st Light Division M. O. vice Phillips resigned.

15th November 1850

The Governor this day appointed and commissioned Norris Montgomery Ensign Independent Regt 53rd Regiment M. O.

The Governor upon the recommendation of the Judges of the Court and many respectable citizens of Queen Anne's County remitted the fine of twenty dollars imposed upon George Hulthoff for selling beer and again upon the Sabbath day

19th November 1850

The Governor this day upon the recommendation of the Jury by whom he was tried and convicted and by many respectable citizens of the City of Baltimore pardoned Simon Cuenick convicted in Baltimore City Court of an assault with intent to commit a rape (see record of finding)
