The Governor dismissed the application of M. P. Galligan for remission of a fine imposed by the Circuit Court for Frederick County.

The Governor assigned the Hon. Henry May, as counsel for the State in the matter of the State of Maryland vs. William Mistor, charged with violating the laws, by using scoops or drags in taking or catching oysters in the waters of this State, now pending before the Court of Appeals upon writ of error from Somerset County Court, in conjunction with John H. Gore and William J. Byrd Inquirers.

The Governor ordered the Adjutant General to have the flag displayed and the usual salute fired at the hour fixed for the inauguration of the Honorable T. Wether's Legion, as Governor of Maryland.
