The Gov this day issued the following Requisition
State of Maryland, to wit:

Thomas Watkins Lyon
Governor of Maryland.

To the Honorable the
Chief Judge of the Circuit Court of the
United States, for the District of Columbia.
It appears by the annexed papers duly authenticated
according to the laws of this State, that a certain
Michael Funk late of Frederick County stands charged
by the Grand Jury of said County with the crime
of Larceny; and it has been represented to me that
the said Michael Funk has fled from ^{the} justice of
this State, and has taken refuge within the District
of Columbia.

Now Therefore, pursuant to the provisions
of the Constitution and Laws of the United States in such
case made and provided, I do hereby request
that the said Michael Funk be apprehended and
delivered to David J. Wachten who is hereby authorized
to receive and convey to the State of Maryland, there
to be dealt with according to law.

of the State of Maryland, this 16th day of February
in the year of our Lord 1854
