

The Governor this day issued a warrant in the usual form to the Sheriff of Baltimore City or any County where party might be found authorizing him to arrest and deliver one J. H. Hunter to Samuel Michaels Agent of the State of Pennsylvania under a Requisition. The said Hunter being a fugitive from Justice charged with an Assault and Battery with intent to kill.

28th

The Governor remitted two fines of \$100 each imposed upon one William H. Hart by the Circuit Court for Allegany County at the January Term 1854 for keeping a gaming table and gaming house.

March 3rd

Notice was received from P. Ford Esq. accepting the appointment of Counsel on the part of the State in the case against Nelson Poyam and Joseph Lawrence for negroes.

Notice received from the Senate of their advising and consenting to certain nominations therein specified.

5th

The Gov. issued his Proclamation offering a Reward of \$200 for the arrest of Samuel H. Stone indicted for the Murder of Elijah Gibson and escaped from jail of Somerset County on the night of the 26th February 1854.

March 7-1854.

The Gov. directed publication of the usual Notice in the matter of the application for the Pardon of William H. Kerchival convicted at Nov. Term 1833 of the Circuit Court for Talbot County of unlawfully shooting John Lockerman and sentenced to Penitentiary for 18 months
